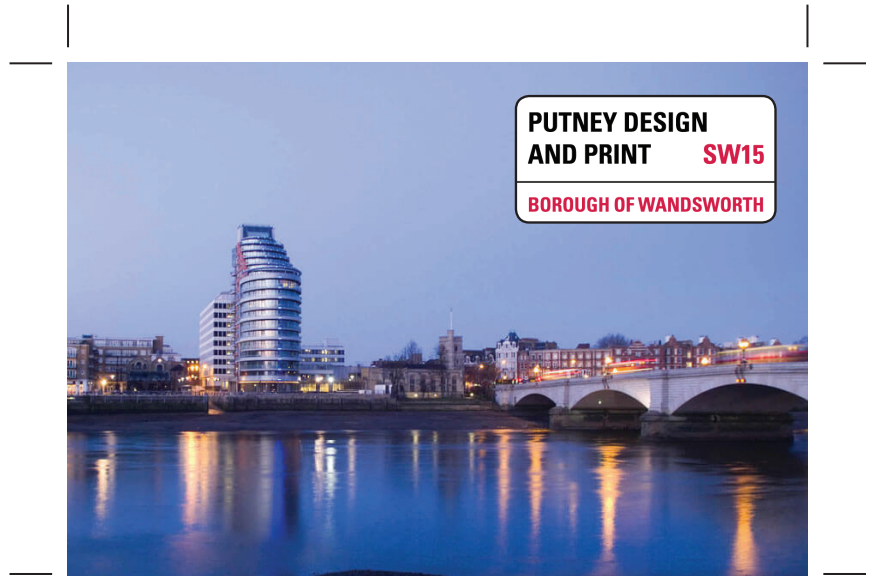
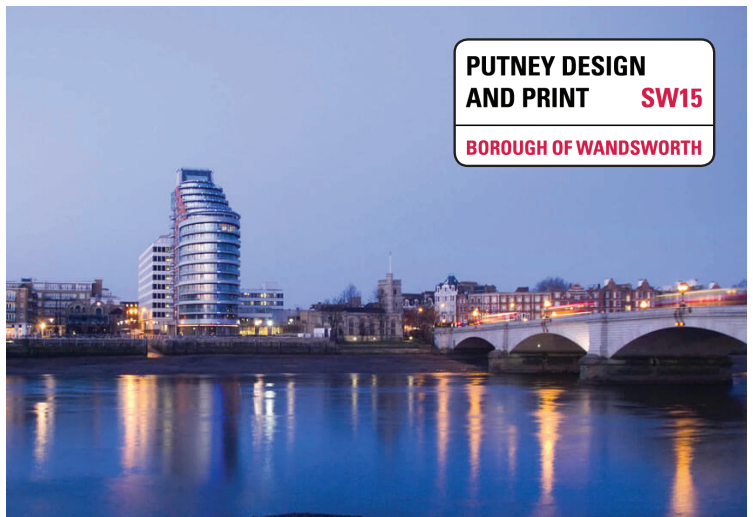


Bleed and crop marks = perfect



Crop marks but no bleed = not what you want



No crop marks, probably no bleed either but no way of knowing because without crop marks you're only guessing at what the finished size is
